Wish List (items needed)

The items on this list need not to be new, just clean and serviceable.

SUPPLIES: backpacks, construction paper ~ variety of different colors, washable paints, hair ties (no metal), beach towels, toys for 1 to 3 years of age.

TECHNOLOGY: Batteries (AA, C, D), CD's (infant, Disney, and Kidz Bop), DVD's (rated G and/or PG), CD/radio players with headphones.

BEDDING (boys & girls): twin comforters, twin sheet sets with pillow cases, crib sheets and comforters, body pillows, positioning pillows, boppy pillows with covers.

FURNITURE: infant mobiles, infant swings, reclining high chairs with wheels, bouncers that vibrate, white dressers - 4 or 5 drawer, baby cribs (both sides that drop down).

CLOTHING (all sizes, boys & girls): socks, sweat pants & shorts, t-shirts, bibs and infant (sizes).
